Local Law No. 1 of the year 1979

A local law Dogs

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the

Village as follows:

Section 1: Definition of Term: Dog - includes both female and male dogs. Owner - includes any person or persons, firm, association, corporation or society owning, harboring, or keeping a dog.

No person being the owner having the custody and control of any dog shall suffer or allow it to run at large in any of the streets or public places of the Village of Hobart, or upon the premises of anyone other than the owner or keeper, unless the owner or occupant of such premises grants permission; and no dog shall be permitted in any public place or street within the Village unless it be effectively restrained by a leash or chain and unless it be attended by a responsible person. No person being the owner having the custody or control of any dog shall suffer or allow it to defecate and allow the feces to remain in any street or public place of the Village of Hobart or upon the premises of anyone other than the owner or keeper unless the owner or occupant grants permission.

Section 2: Enforcements: It shall be the duty of the person or officer authorized by Article 70 of the Agriculture and Markets Law as amended to enforce the provisions of this local law and to take into possession any dogs running at large, to be disposed of in the same manner and under the same circumstances provided for unlicensed or untagged dogs under section 114 of the Agriculture and Markets Law as amended.

Section 3: Violation and Penalty: Any person violating any of the foregoing provisions shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$10.00 for a first offense, \$25.00 for a second offense, and \$35.00 for a third and any subsequent offense and each violation of any provision of this local law shall constitute disorderly conduct, and any person violating the same shall be a disorderly person.

Section 4: This local law shall take effect immediately.
